Page 3, Chapter 3.2, 2nd paragraph

Current text:

For the purpose of this call, all schools and higher education institutions specified by Member States (participating countries), and all institutions or organisations providing learning opportunities which have received over 50 % of their annual revenues from public sources over the last two years, or which are controlled by public bodies or their representatives, are considered to be public bodies. Such organisations are required to sign a declaration of honour stating that their organisation complies with the above-mentioned definition of public body.

Revised text:

For the purpose of this call, all schools and higher education institutions specified by Member States (participating countries), and all institutions or organisations providing learning opportunities which have received over 50 % of their annual revenues from public sources over the last two years, or which are controlled by public bodies or their representatives, are considered to be public bodies. Such organisations are required to sign a declaration of honour stating that their organisation complies with the conditions mentioned above.

Revised text:

comply with the requirements laid down in the Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing the Lifelong Learning Programme, specifically Article 2 (Definitions), Article 4 (Access to the Lifelong Learning programme), as well as the articles regarding access to the sub-programmes: Article 16 (Comenius), Article 20 (Erasmus), Article 24 (Leonardo da Vinci), Article 28 (Grundtvig), Article 32 (Transversal Programme) and Article 34 (Jean Monnet);

Page 12, Annex I, Comenius Programme, Multilateral projects, footnote (3):

Page 16, Annex II, Erasmus Programme, Point 2, 2nd bullet point:

Current text:

Students must be registered in higher education institutions which hold an Erasmus University Charter (standard or extended)

Revised text:

Students must be registered in higher education institutions which hold an Extended Erasmus University Charter ~~(standard or extended)~~

Page 25, Annex V Chapter 1.1 2nd paragraph:

Current text:

For Grundtvig and Comenius mobility, the support to subsistence cost covers also insurance costs of the persons in mobility. For Erasmus student Mobility and Leonardo training placements, the support to subsistence cost covers also travel cost.

Revised text:

For Grundtvig and Comenius mobility, the support to subsistence cost covers also insurance costs of the persons in mobility. For Erasmus student mobility and Leonardo Mobility placements, insurance costs are normally covered by "other costs" (organisation of mobility, point 3.2). National Agencies may, however, decide within this call to have insurance costs covered by the subsistence costs instead.

For Erasmus student Mobility and Leonardo training placements, the support to subsistence cost covers also travel cost.

Page 27, Annex V Chapter 3.2

Current text:

All amounts are in EUR per person/beneficiary unless otherwise indicated. This category covers also insurance costs of the persons in mobility, except for Grundtvig and Comenius mobility, where insurance is covered by subsistence costs.

Revised text:

All amounts are in EUR per person/beneficiary unless otherwise indicated. This category covers also insurance costs of the persons in mobility, except for Grundtvig and Comenius mobility, where insurance is covered by subsistence costs. National Agencies may, however, decide within this call to have insurance costs covered by the subsistence costs also for Erasmus and Leonardo mobility (see Chapter 1.1).
